



# Q1. First, are you or any of your immediate family a member of the news media, a public relations firm, or actively working for a political campaign?




## Q2. Are you currently registered to vote?

















#### Q11. Do you think our country is more or less safe with President Trump than we would have been if Biden or Harris were in the White House?




































#### Which of the following best describes your race or ethnicity?








