



Survey of Likely 2026 General Election Voters National

July 1 – 2, 2025 | n=1500 | ±2.51%



- For the first time since September 2022, **threats to democracy** (18%) **has overtaken inflation and the economy** (17%) **as the top priority** among likely voters.
 - This marks an 18-point drop for inflation/economy since April. The shift most recently is largely driven by:
 - Democrats (-15 net since June)
 - Younger voters (-17 net since June)
 - Non-white voters (-11 net since June)
- 8 months after the 2024 Presidential election, Kamala **Harris** (-8 net fav) is **still viewed more net-unfavorably than Trump** (-5), Rubio (-1), Noem (-5), and Hegseth (-4).
 - Among union households, Trump's image has declined -20 net fav since June, and these voters now view Harris more favorably by 10 net points.
- Before and after **Trump's ICE deportation raids** (late May / early June 2025):
 - Over 70% of voters believe individuals entering the U.S. without legal permission have broken the law.
 - Over 60% support deporting those individuals back to their country of origin.
 - Hispanic voters are now 11 points more likely to support deportation than two months ago.
- However, **support for ICE raids specifically is more divided** (50–48) with this split driven largely by:
 - Older women moved from +32 net on generic deportation to net-even on ICE raids.
 - Non-college educated women moved from +26 net to net-even.



- Voter blame for the LA riots varies sharply by gender:
 - 45% of **men** (+11 over next highest) blame protest organizers.
 - 45% of **women** (+15 over next highest) blame federal ICE agents.
- **50% of voters believe Israel was justified** in launching Operation Rising Lion, a **14-point margin in favor**, driven largely by men (+29 net justified).
 - Among consistent voters, 51% of those who voted in 3 of the last 4 elections agree; 52% of 4-of-4 voters agree.
- **57% believe Trump was justified in destroying Iran's nuclear capabilities**, with voters 6% more likely to say he was *definitely* justified (41%) than not justified altogether (35%).
 - Swing voters: 58-32 in favor (net +4 over the topline).
 - A quarter of Democrats also say Trump was justified.
- 43% of voters cite **religious and ideological differences as the primary cause of Israel-Iran conflict**, 20 points higher than the next leading cause.
 - Voters 55+ are 12 points more likely than younger voters to cite Iran's nuclear ambitions.
 - Fox News viewers: +15 points more likely to cite Iran's nuclear pursuit.
 - MSNBC viewers: +9 points more likely to say Israel's military aggression.
- Half of voters believe **Trump keeps campaign promises better than most politicians**, with 38% saying "much better than most".
 - Among Trump Switchers and Newcomers (didn't vote Trump in 2020 but did in 2024): 78% say he keeps promises better than most.



- Swing voters: 2:1 more likely to say Trump is better at keeping promises.
- On nearly every key issue, **voters prefer Texas as a national model over California**, except on abortion, which ranks lowest (1%) in top priorities.
 - 30% of Democrats say Texas is a better model on inflation and cost of living.
- **Cable network** and **prime-time TV shows viewership** have fairly strong **partisan contours** when looking at those who watch a given network on at least a weekly basis.
 - 58% of Republicans watch Fox News basis, compared to only 38% of Democrats who watch MSNBC.
 - Black voters (25%) are the most likely to watch Lifetime.
 - Independents are the least likely to watch any of the top cable networks.
 - 19% of married women watch ESPN.
 - Those in a union household (23%) are the most likely to watch HGTV.
 - Half of voters do not watch any of the top 10 most popular prime-time shows.
 - Non-white voters are more likely than white voters to watch prime-time television.
- Advanced Segmentation Analysis produced three very interesting segments this month: *Liberals* (34%), *Moderates* (27%), and *Conservative* (39%).
 - Conservatives are focused on illegal immigration / border security (31%) and government spending / waste (25%), while Liberals care about threats to democracy (45%). Moderates are concerned with inflation / economy (24%) and Social Security / Medicare (15%).



- Moderates are 2:1 negative on the direction of the country (30% right direction, 60% wrong track) and currently lean heavily left on the generic ballot (30 R, 53 D). This appears to be driven by their dislike of Donald Trump (33 fav, 62 unfav).
- However, the way President Trump is handling the issue of illegal immigration is supported by *Moderates* – 71% agree that those here illegally are breaking the law, and 58% agree they should be deported back to their country of origin.
- The *Moderates* segment is overwhelmingly female (65%), leans Democratic (44%), only 41% married, and much lower in income than either the *Conservative* or *Liberal* groups. These voters are lower in educational attainment (only 32% have a college degree).
