
## **Survey Objectives & Key Findings**

- 2025 VA Gubernatorial Race (Spanberger +3.1%)
- 2025 VA Lieutenant Gubernatorial Race (Hashmi +4.9%)
- 2025 VA Attorney General Race (Jones +2.7%)
- Direction of State (Wrong Track -2.4%)
- Glenn Youngkin Approval (Disapprove -0.2%)

# Methodology

Respondents were recruited through an online, opt-in panel conducted in English. Results were weighted to be representative of Virginia's active voter population based on age (determined by targeted recruitment), sex, race, education, political ideology, and recalled 2024 presidential vote. A synthetic post-stratification frame was constructed using population benchmarks from 2021 gubernatorial and 2024 presidential election exit poll data. Statistical modeling was employed to account for non-response.









This poll used a nonprobability, opt-in panel. While weighting and statistical modeling were applied to improve representativeness, results should be interpreted with caution when generalizing to the broader population. Furthermore, traditional margins of error do not apply to nonprobability samples; instead, we report credible intervals, which reflect sampling uncertainties and assume the validity of our model.
