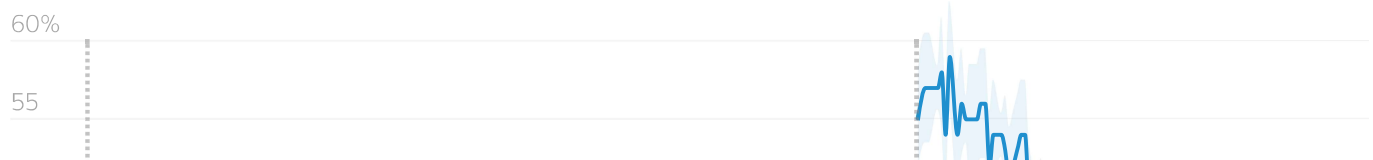

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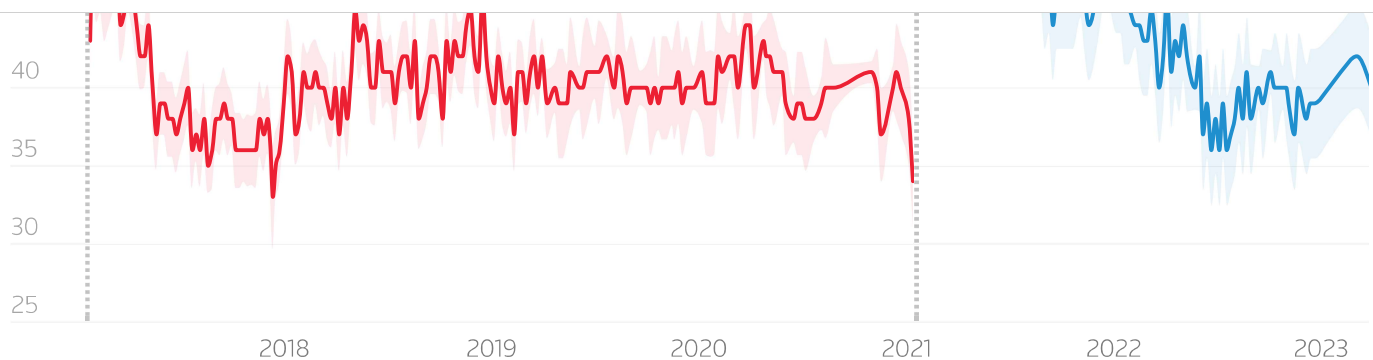
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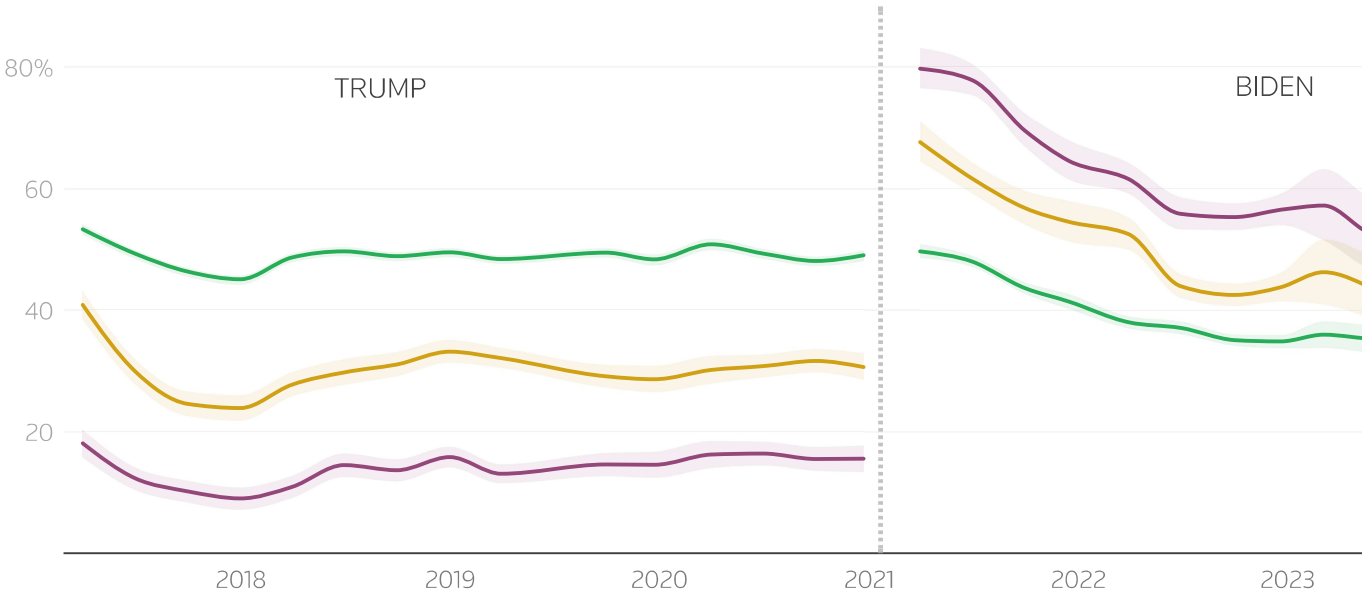

BY RACE AND ETHNICITY

Political views in the United States sometimes skew sharply along racial and ethnic lines. Hispanic voters have often favored the Democratic Party but exit polls show Donald Trump captured a larger share of the Hispanic vote in the 2024 presidential election than he did in past contests.

How does the president's approval rating vary by group?

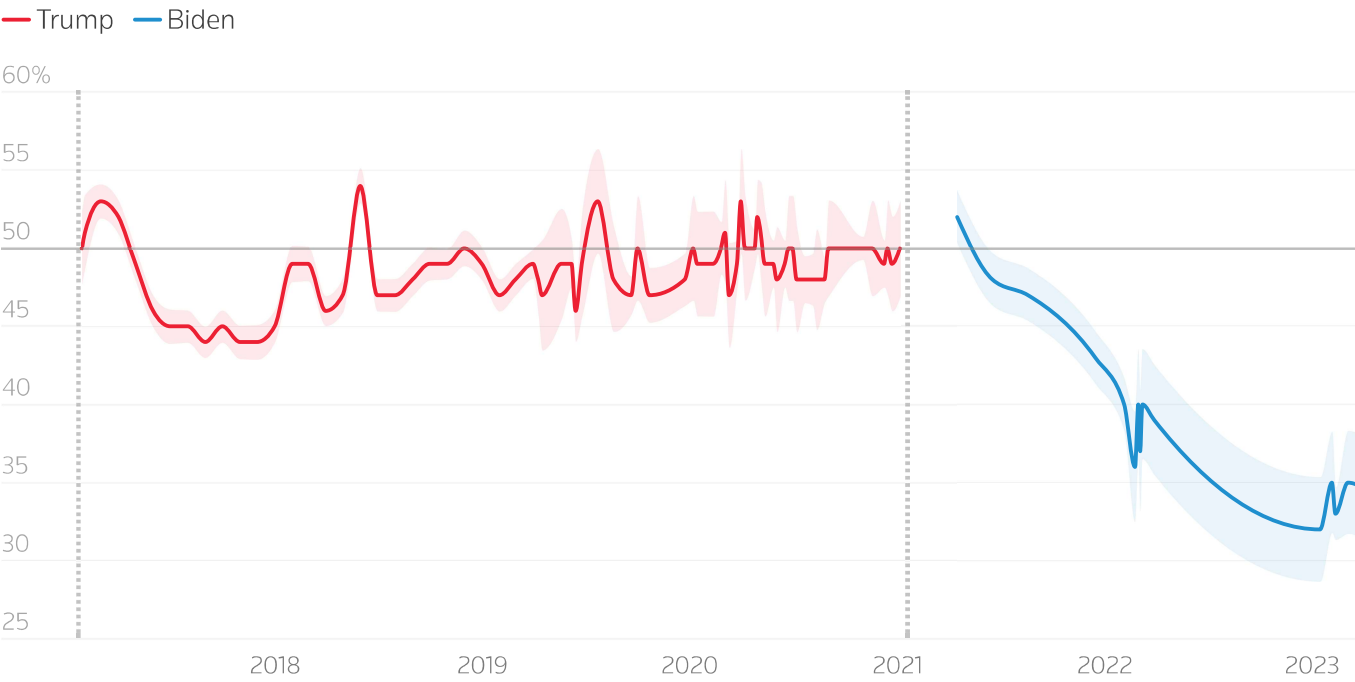

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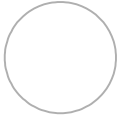
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
