Conway Competitive in U.S. House Democratic Primary

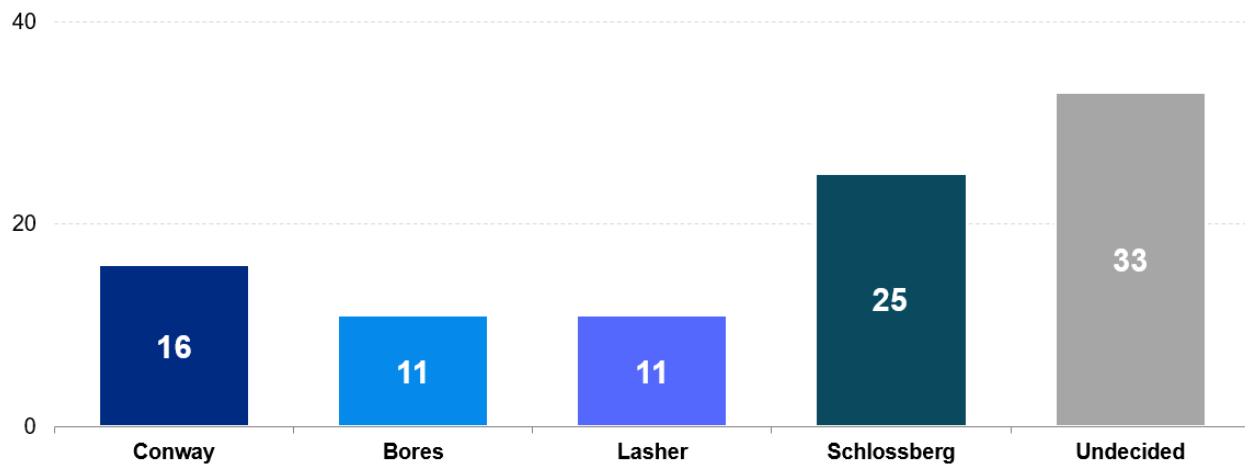

A recent survey of Democratic primary voters in New York's 12th Congressional District shows a wide-open race. George Conway currently sits in second place (16 percent) and in a competitive position with the plurality of voters undecided. George Conway (16 percent) leads state assembly members Micah Lasher (11 percent) and Alex Bores (11 percent), trailing only Jack Schlossberg.

I know it's a long way off, but thinking about the Democratic primary election for U.S. Congress in 2026, if the Democratic primary election for U.S. Congress were held today, for whom would you vote -- George Conway, Alex Bores, Micah Lasher, Jack Schlossberg, or some other candidate?



This memo is based on a survey conducted among 500 likely Democratic primary voters in New York's 12th Congressional District from February 25 – March 2, 2026. This was conducted via cell phone and landline and has a margin of error of 4.38 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence interval. Survey respondents were contacted utilizing voter file sample. The survey data are weighted to ensure regional and demographic composition reflects that of estimated likely 2026 Democratic Primary voters in NY-12.
