Analysis by InsiderAdvantage pollster Matt Towery: "Our firm has successfully polled South Carolina but I normally defer to my colleague and top South Carolina pollster Robert Cahaly of The Trafalgar Group discussing his home state. My single observation is that I have never, ever, seen statewide race on Election Day with such high numbers of undecided voters. This means one of two things. Either turnout is apathetic and turnout will be anemic, or there could be some shocking results in some of these races."
