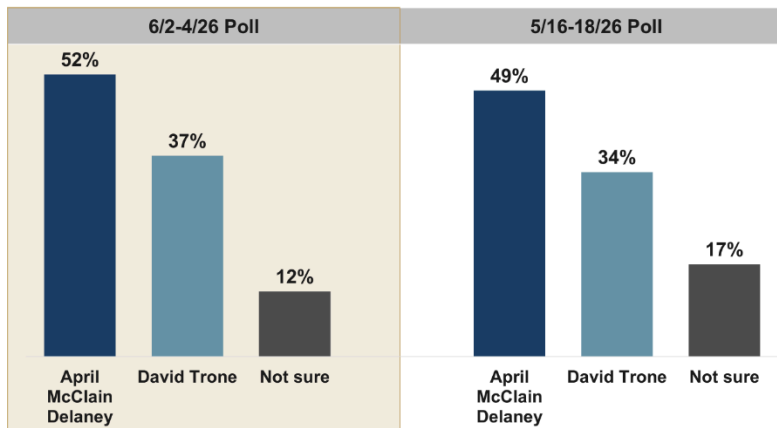

RE: Congresswoman April McClain Delaney maintains double-digit lead and crosses 50% threshold for first time

Hart Research Associates conducted a survey between June 2 and 4, 2026, among 500 likely Maryland 6th CD Democratic primary voters via landline and cell phone. The survey was representative of a 6th CD Democratic primary electorate by key demographic and geographic factors and has a margin of error of $\pm 4.5\%$.

Congresswoman McClain Delaney’s current 15-point lead over David Trone remains unchanged from our mid-May survey, but she has passed the 50% threshold for the first time in the primary campaign as “undecideds” drop as the June 23rd primary date draws nearer.



As has been the case in previous surveys, McClain Delaney leads by double-digits among the large majority of the electorate that is POSITIVE toward both candidates. And McClain Delaney also leads by a similar double-digit margin among the (smaller but growing) share of the electorate that is negative toward McClain Delaney OR Trone (or both).
