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■ Poll Finds Tied Race for Ohio Attorney General, Path to Victory for Democrat John Kulewicz

A new Tulchin Research poll of 600 likely November 2026 general election voters in Ohio reveals a dead-heat race for Attorney General in a highly competitive political environment – and establishes a clear path to victory for Democrat John Kulewicz. The survey finds Democrats demonstrating vital momentum at the top of the ticket in the races for U.S. Senate and Governor. In the Attorney General race, Kulewicz begins tied with Republican Keith Faber and takes the lead once voters learn more about the candidates.

Top-of-Ticket Democratic Leads and Tied AG Race Signal Major Opportunity


Our polling reveals that Ohio is a highly competitive, winnable political battleground for Democrats in 2026. In the race for U.S. Senate, Democrat Sherrod Brown leads Republican Jon Husted by 4 points (46% to 42%), with Libertarian Bill Redpath at 4% and 7% undecided. In the race for Governor, Democrat Amy Acton leads Republican Vivek Ramaswamy by 3 points (47% to 44%), with Libertarian Don Kissick at 4% and 6% undecided.

In this environment, the race for Attorney General is tied, with both Democrat John Kulewicz and Republican Keith Faber receiving 34%. Crucially, neither Kulewicz (21% Total ID) nor Faber (27% Total ID) is currently well known to the electorate, and a third of voters (32%) remain undecided.

Kulewicz Surges Into the Lead on the Informed Ballot

When respondents are presented with balanced information about both candidates, Kulewicz captures a larger share of undecided voters and takes the lead. Following balanced profile statements, Kulewicz leads by a margin of 4 points, 43% to 39%.

Conclusion

Our polling demonstrates that John Kulewicz is in a strong position to win the race for Ohio Attorney General. With a highly competitive political climate favoring Democrats at the top of the ticket, an initially tied race, and a 4-point lead in the informed trial heat, Kulewicz has a clear and viable path to victory assuming he has the necessary resources to effectively communicate his message to the electorate.

Survey Methodology: From June 2-4, 2026, Tulchin Research conducted a survey among 600 likely November 2026 general election voters in Ohio. The margin of error for the survey is ±4 percentage points.
