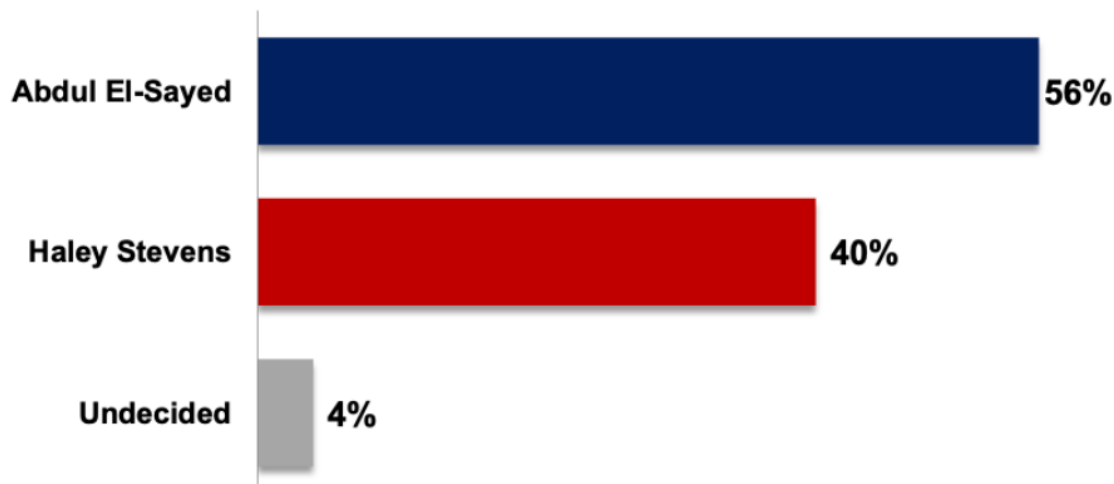


Abdul El-Sayed Leads in Head-to-Head Matchup

Abdul El-Sayed leads Haley Stevens 56% to 40% (+16), leaving just 4% of primary voters still undecided. Following Mallory McMorrow's withdrawal from the race, El-Sayed has effectively consolidated the electorate and vaulted past the 50% mark.



El-Sayed Retains Massive Popularity Advantage

The underlying personal popularity of the two candidates continues to define the trajectory of this primary. El-Sayed maintains a broad and deeply resilient well of goodwill among likely primary voters, outpacing Stevens's net popularity by 31 percentage points.

- **Abdul El-Sayed** sustains a strong **69% favorable** rating to 17% unfavorable (**+51 net favorable**).
- **Haley Stevens** enters the final stage of the race with a significantly more fractured image at **54% favorable** and **34% unfavorable** (**+20 net favorable**).
